

SPECIFIC TYPES OF POWER WHEELCHAIRS:

Per Medicare policy, patient requiring multiple power (power seating system, power tilt and recline seating system, alternate drive control interface, push-rim activated power assist, a drive control interface other than a hand or chin-operated standard proportional joystick (examples include but are not limited to head control, sip and puff, switch control)) must be evaluated by a certified RESNA-certified Assistive Technology Supplier (ATS) or Assistive Technology Practitioner (ATP).

The RESNA- certified ATS or ATP must have direct, in-person involvement in the wheelchair selection for the patient.

The specialty evaluation report issued by the ATS or ATP is in addition to the physician's assessment of the patient for the power mobility device. The specialty reports provides detailed information explaining why each specific option or accessory i.e., or is needed to address the patient's mobility limitation.
